Summary of Changes

August 2020

DLM 740, 750 and 760 are being combined and are now on general release as DLM 760.

Consultation Manager

- **Test Results** - The results for the following structured data areas (SDA's) have been updated to record up to 3 decimal points:
 - **Blood lipids**
 - **Immunoglobulin**
 - **Other Biochemistry Tests**
 - **Other Lab Tests**
 - **Urine Biochemistry**
- **New Seasonal Influenza Immunisations** – New seasonal influenza vaccines have been added to the Immunisation **Structured Data Area (SDA)**:
 - Influenza aTIV (adjuvant)

 - Influenza aTIV (adjuvant) – Pha

- **Sort Patients by Surname (Patient Groups)** - The issue with Sort Patients by Surname not working has been addressed.

England

Control Panel


- Organisation **codes (ODS)** – From April 2020, new organisations in England have an ODS code in the format of ANANA (A is alphabetical, N is numeric). Vision **Control Panel** now reflects this. See [Adding an Organisation](#) on page 5.

Patient Facing Services

- **Patient Services** – The letter created when a patient registers for Patient Services, now includes a web address that contains a list of all available paired suppliers of patient facing services.



Scotland


Electronic Test Requesting

- **Community Health Index (CHI) number** - A patient's CHI number is now automatically included in the information passed to an electronic test requesting service when a test request is entered.
- **Prescribing Number** - A clinician's prescribing number is now automatically included in the information passed to an electronic test requesting service when a test request is entered.

Wales

Quality Assurance and Improvement Framework

- **QAIF (previously QOF)** - In line with policy changes in Wales, the operational period for Quality Assurance and Improvement Framework (QAIF) has been updated to 1st October - 30th September.
 - **Clinical Audit** - The **Reference** date now displays as 01 October.





Adding an Organisation

To add a new organisation with an **ODS** code:




Note – There is no change for existing organisations.

1. From the **Vision** front screen, select **Management Tools – Control Panel**.



2. From **File Maintenance**, select **Organisation**.

3. Highlight the category you want to add the new organisation to, for




example, **Hospital** and select **Add**.

4. The **Organisation Details** screen displays, complete as required:




Note – The details required to complete the screen vary depending on the type of organisation you are adding.




- **Name** – Type the full name of the organisation.
- **Mnemonic** - Up to five characters are available here for a short unique name to refer to the organisation.

1. Select the **Identifiers**  tab.

- From the dropdown list, select **NHS Trust Code** or **Non-NHS Trust Code**:



- Type the **ODS** number in **Identifier Value**:



- Finally, select **OK** and **OK** again, to exit the **Organisation Details** screen.
