

GP2GP Processing - EMIS vs Vision 3

The following table is designed to help you transition from using **EMIS** to **Vision 3** for GP2GP record processing:

	EMIS	Vision 3
1	Patient registers at the new practice and the records are requested from the Practitioner Services Division (PSD).	Patient registers at the new practice and the records are automatically requested from the Practitioner Services Division (PSD).
	The patient's previous practice checks GP links takes a note of the patient, and exports the records through Docman. Note - GP2GP still works the same for EMIS PCS as Vision 3 , for example, GP2GP does not work for large messages, remove the tick from Docman and export the old way.	The patient's previous practice check Registration Links , take note of the patient, and export the records through Docman , see <u>GP2GP - Deducting a Patient</u> in the Consultation Manager Help Centre for details. Note - GP2GP still works the same for EMIS PCS as Vision 3 , for example, GP2GP does not work for large messages, remove the tick from Docman and export the old way.
2	The GP2GP record is received in Workflow and you work through the records received as required, for example, allergies and medication.	 Once you have imported a patient record from Docman, see <u>GP2GP</u>- <u>Importing a Docman Record</u> in the Consultation Manager Help Centre for details, the records display in Mail Manager - Incoming - GP2GP. Right click on the message and select File All, see <u>Filing the Record</u> <u>Received</u> in the Consultation Manager Help Centre for details. Add a Reminder to the patient record, see <u>Adding Reminders to Identify</u> <u>Patients with a GP2GP Record</u> in the Consultation Manager Help Centre for details.
3	The record is filed.	 Review degraded data and updated where appropriate, see Processing Degraded Data - Scotland in the Consultation Manager Help Centre for details. Review medication, see , see Processing Degraded Data - Scotland in the Consultation Manager Help Centre for details.
5	Notes summarised.	Notes summarised.
