

## **SNOMED CT Changes and New Vision Local Codes October 2019**

## Introduction

This is the change report for the October 2019 SNOMED CT dictionary.

As you may be aware, Vision 3 dual codes all data, data is entered using Read codes and mapped to SNOMED CT behind the scenes. From April 2018 there are additions to SNOMED CT that cannot not be directly mapped to existing Read codes. These can be recorded in Vision Anywhere, which is fully SNOMED CT compliant. This change report provides the link to the SNOMED CT update information and lists the Vision local codes we are introducing to ensure you can utilise the new SNOMED CT codes that cannot be directly mapped to Read codes within Vision 3.
