My Health Online (MHOL) release 2 contains the following new features and improvements:

- **Log in** - There is now a single combined **Welcome** and **Log in** screen for your patients, simplifying and speeding up their logging in process:



Login

Access to this system is permitted to authorised users ONLY. Unauthorised attempts are considered a criminal offence and could be prosecuted.

Due to continual development, My Health Online now provides functionality which allows automatic switch on of additional features. Logging in to My Health Online indicates your acceptance to receive additional My Health Online features that your practice may now offer. It is recommended that you visit NHS Wales Informatics Service for information about keeping your My Health Online information Safe and Secure. If you do not wish to continue receiving any additional features, you will need to contact your Practice to advise.

Your GP Practice provides this website in collaboration with NHS Wales.

Once you've created an account you will be able to use the features your GP practice has made available, which may include:

- Book and cancel appointments
- Request repeat prescriptions
- Update personal information

Before being able to create an account you must first get a registration letter from your GP.

As part of the registration process you will be asked to prove your identity. This is one of the measures in place to protect the information that your GP holds about you. Full details about the process are available from your GP practice.



- **My Medical Summary** - The patient's Immunisation records now displays alongside their **Allergies** and **Medication**:

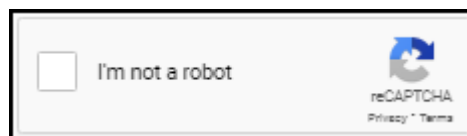
