This useful checklist details the key tasks you must carry out to prepare you for Accuracy Check



Tasks to complete

2 weeks before Go Live



Pharmacy Process - Accuracy Check

Be aware that once **Accuracy Check** is enabled, all eligible prescriptions require an accuracy check. Please note that non-EPS prescriptions are not eligible for Accuracy Check. Ensure you have space next to a PC for carrying this out, consider how this will work in your pharmacy.

What does Accuracy Check mean for me?

- Enabling Accuracy Check has shown a 80% reduction in near misses.
- Be aware you cannot claim for a prescription until **Accuracy Check** is completed.
