

# What Do You Need To Do?

This useful checklist details the key tasks you must carry out to prepare you for Handout Manager and Accuracy Check

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# Tasks to complete

## 2 weeks before Go Live



## Clear items awaiting collection

Make sure all uncollected prescriptions are collected as soon as possible, and no prescriptions older than 4 weeks are left in the collection baskets before Go-Live.

## **Plan your locations**

Plan how many locations you need to configure as part of the **Handout Manager** activation process, for example, shelves, fridges, Controlled Drugs cabinets.



## Pharmacy Process - Handout Manager

Keep in mind, initially your current collection process may need to run alongside your new **Handout Manager** collection process, until all the medication dispensed prior to the activation of **Handout Manager** is collected.

## **Pharmacy Process - Accuracy Check**

Be aware that once **Accuracy Check** is enabled, all eligible prescriptions require an accuracy check. Please note that non-EPS prescriptions are not eligible for Accuracy Check.

Ensure you have space next to a PC for carrying this out, consider how this will work in your pharmacy.

#### What does Accuracy Check mean for me?

- Enabling Accuracy Check has shown a 80% reduction in near misses.
- Be aware you cannot claim for a prescription until Accuracy Check is completed.

## Tasks to complete 1 week before Go Live

## Clear items awaiting collection - Continued

Make sure all uncollected prescriptions are collected as soon as possible, and no prescriptions older than 4 weeks are left in the collection baskets before Go-Live.

## Install Wi-Fi Unit

Install your wireless access point, if not already done, according to the instructions in the package and check that it is displaying a continuous blue light to indicate correct installation. <u>See here for details</u>.



## Create User Accounts

Each **Pharmacy Manager** user must have their own user account to use **Handout Manager**. Ensure to assign a job role to each user. <u>See here for details</u>.

Accuracy Check	
Check Label Settings When using Accuracy Check a QR code prints on your item and bag labels, as well as a new picking list. You may need to adjust the standard position of the QR codes if you use pre-printed labels. See here for details.	
In Progress Prescriptions Screen Familiarise yourself with the new In Progress screen in Pharmacy Manager. See here for details.	
Clinical Checks Clinical checks to be carried out on all prescriptions prior to dispensing. <u>See here for details</u> .
