

## Pharmacy Manager Quick Reference Guide Recording a Pharmacy First Scotland -Standard (MAS) Consultation

### Who is eligible?

- People registered with the Defence Medical services (even if they are a visitor to Scotland).
- People registered on a permanent basis with a GP Practice in Scotland.
- People registered on a temporary basis with a GP Practice in Scotland (unless they are a visitor to Scotland).
- People who live in Scotland.
- People who are gypsies or travellers in Scotland.
- People who are asylum seekers in Scotland or a dependent of an asylum seeker in Scotland.

### What is a Pharmacy First Scotland - Standard (MAS) Consultation?

The Pharmacy First Service enables patients to get advice and free treatment from a Pharmacist for a range of minor ailments, for example, nasal congestion, migraines, fungal skin infections, eczema.

A patient must be eligible for the Pharmacy First Service before a consultation can take place. Eligible patients include those who are registered with a GP practice in Scotland or who live in Scotland.

To record a Pharmacy First Scotland - Standard (MAS) consultation:

1. From the **Pharmacy Manager Side Navigation Bar** select **ePharmacy**

# Configuring Pharmacy First Scotland -Standard (MAS) Form Printing

You can configure to print Pharmacy First Scotland - Standard (MAS) forms at a system level. This feature is enabled by default within **Pharmacy Manager**.

If you wish to support paperless dispensing within your pharmacy, you can disable this feature.

To disable Pharmacy First Scotland - Standard (MAS) form printing at a system level:

1. From the **Pharmacy Manager Menus** select **Tools** - **System Settings** - **Pharmacy Details**:

## Pharmacy First Scotland - Standard (MAS) Approved List

**Pharmacy Manager** warns you if an item supplied during a Pharmacy First Scotland - Standard (MAS) consultation is not on the Pharmacy First Scotland approved list, but allows you to continue dispensing.

**Note** - The approved list is not checked for any Pharmacy First Scotland service other than Pharmacy First Scotland -Standard (MAS).

This is especially useful when new items are added at short notice to the online version of the Pharmacy First Scotland approved list, but have not yet been included in the **Pharmacy Manager** Product file update.

**Note** - You should always check the online version of the Pharmacy First Scotland approved list to ensure the item you wish to dispense is on the list. If you dispense an item that is not on the list, you may not be paid.

To dispense an item outside of the Pharmacy First Scotland approved list:

- 1. Record a Pharmacy First Scotland Standard (MAS) consultation and dispense the medication in the usual way.
- 2. If the item is not recognised as being on the Pharmacy First Scotland approved list the below message displays:

- 3. Select **Confirm** to continue with the dispense, or select **Close** to abandon the dispense.
- 4. After dispensing an item outside of the Pharmacy First Scotland approved list, an internal audit event is logged in **Patient Details History**, confirming which user continued with the dispensing:
