## Summary of Changes: All Countries

- Quantity Matching Customers who dispense with a robot in their pharmacy are now able to use Pharmacy Manager's Quantity Matching feature. If enabled, electronic scripts will automatically populate the quantity field at the point of dispensing.
- Disabling Quantity Matching Disable it within Tools System Settings Pharmacy Details - Electronic Messaging - Quantity Matching.

# Summary of Changes: England Only

• **Real Time Exemption Check (RTEC)** – This is automatically enabled with v11.5 and provides users with the exemption status of a patient before dispensing their prescription.

## Summary of Changes: Scotland Only

 Changes in the naming of services – In line with Scottish guidance, we have renamed the CMS service (Chronic Medication Service) to MCR (Medicines: Care & Review) to align with a service relaunch. The functionality remains the same.

We have also amended the names of other ePharmacy services, to align with the latest specification from NHS Scotland. These changes are outlined below:

- eAMS has been renamed AMS
- eMAS has been renamed MAS
- eUCF has been renamed UCF

# Running a Backup in the Background

You can now run a backup in the background and continue to use Pharmacy Manager while the backup is running. To run a backup:

- Check your external media, usually a USB drive is inserted in your machine.
- 2. Double click on Notification

**Centre - Backup not run** and select **Yes** to the message asking if you want to run the backup.

 The backup runs in the background and you can see it's progress in the Notification Centre.





### Fridge Temperature Report

Producing a **Fridge Temperatures** report helps you obtain an accurate reading of the temperature your fridge(s) are being kept at. To run a report:

- From the Fridge Temperatures tile, select View More .
- 2. The **Fridge Temperatures** screen displays.
- 3. Select Export EXPORT

#### **Reordering Useful Links**

Users can drag and drop useful links into their desired order on the Useful Links tile.

- 1. Select Edit EDIT
- Choose a useful link and drag and drop it into your desired position.
- 3. Repeat if required.

### Using Real Time Exemption Check (RTEC): England Only

**RTEC** allows users to automatically check the exemption status of a patient when dispensing a prescription in Pharmacy Manager. RTEC functionality is automatically enabled in v11.5.

To use RTEC:

- 1. From the **eMessages** screen, select and dispense a prescription that is **Ready to Dispense**.
- 2. The **Dispensary** screen displays and RTEC automatically informs you of the patient's exemption status. This information displays:
  - Under the **Patient name**
  - In the Warnings section of the screen

### **Running a Manual Exemption Check: England Only**

#### Running a Manual Exemption Check – eMessages Screen

In the event that an automatic RTEC fails, you can run a manual exemption check from the **eMessages** screen:

- Select the prescription and select
   Prescription Details.
- 2. The **eMessage Details** screen displays.
- 3. Select Check real time exemption.
- 4. The patient's exemption status displays.

### Changes to the FP10 Prescription Form

Pharmacy Manager now supports the changes to the FP10 Prescription form. This includes:

- Universal Credit A new exemption box for patients who receive Universal Credit.
- Combination of the age exemption boxes –
   Exemption Box A: "60 years of age or over or is under 16 years of age".
- **FS Endorsement** Introduction of a new prescriber endorsement 'FS' for 'free supply of sexual health treatment' to enable prescribers to endorse prescriptions for STIs.

### Accessing Patient's Summary Care Record (SCR): England Only

To assist you in making informed clinical decisions for your patient, you can now access a patient's Summary Care Record (SCR) from within Pharmacy Manager.

To view a patient's SCR:

- From Pharmacy Manager, select the patient in the usual way from either:
  - Patient search, or
  - The **Dispensary b** screen.
- 2. From the **Find Patient** screen with the patient required highlighted, select **Details** .
- The Patient Details screen displays, select the Medication tab.
- 4. Now, select View patient's SCR



5. The Summary Care Record screen displays.



### Patient Summary Care Record - Audit Report: England Only

SCR access is audited and presented in a new audit report, available from the **Reporting** tab of Pharmacy Manager.

To run an **SCR Audit Report**, from the

**Reports** screen in Pharmacy Manager:

- Select Audit Report SCR from the list of available reports.
- 2. Apply the required filters.
- 3. Select OK.



Note - Only users with admin rights can view this report
