

# Pharmacy Services Release 7.2

## Summary of Changes

**Pharmacy Services** release **7.2** contains the following new features and improvements:

### Pharmacy First (Formerly CPCS)

- **GP Connect - Update Record** - Information regarding allergies, sensitivities, and the duration of symptoms recorded during **Minor Illness/Clinical Pathways** consultations is now included in the electronic notification sent to a patient's registered GP practice and in the GP Notification PDF.
- **Pharmacy First (Formerly CPCS) Completed** - The **Completed** screen now provides a summary of completed claimable consultations from the last month:
