Pre-requisite Information

The following are the minimum requirements for **Appointments Reporting**:

- Minimum version of Vision 3 practices Vision 3 release DLM 580.
- Windows Desktop Windows 7 or 10.
- .NET4.6.1 or above.
- Internet Connectivity The minimum requirement for connectivity is 3G. Wired internet or Wi-Fi is recommended for faster connectivity.

If you have previously used **Appointments Reporting** app, please uninstall this following via **Control Panel – Program and Features - Uninstall**.
