SIS 10510 delivers the following Vision+ changes:

Summary of Changes

May 2020

Vision+ SNOMED CT

-  **SNOMED CT** – The latest **SNOMED CT** April dictionary is implemented in SIS 10510 and includes the Coronavirus concepts. For more information on Vision's Coronavirus guidance see - <https://info.visionhealth.co.uk/coronavirus-advice>

 **Note** – All countries now have access to the Coronavirus clinical terms in Vision 3 (using local terms). However, in the background the entry is mapped to a SNOMED CT term. QOF

-  **QOF England** – SIS 10510 removes the restriction to only display sixty SNOMED CT terms in a QOF template.

Vision+ Template Designer

-  **Codeset Rows** – When adding a Codeset row to a template, you can hide the SNOMED CT term/Read code and description, so it does not display when viewing the template in the patient record. See [Hiding the description on a Codeset Row](#).
-  **SNOMED CT Browser Search** – The SNOMED CT browser within Template Designer now defaults to **Terms** when searching for a SNOMED CT term. See [SNOMED CT Browser Search](#)
-  **SNOMED CT Filter Options** – Previously if you entered a SNOMED CT term in the search box, then changed the search options, for example, Hierarchy, the SNOMED CT term was removed and required re-entering. SIS 10510 fixes this issue. See [SNOMED CT Browser Search](#)

Vision+ Reports

-  **SNOMED Reports** – Reports within **Practice Lists** that include SNOMED CT terms run faster on receipt of SIS 10510.
-  **Data Extracts** – The **Data Extract** option from **Practice Reports** enables data to be extracted into a CSV (Comma Separated Value) file and forwarded to HB's. The issue of extracts being downloaded every night regardless of version number is addressed.
-  **Contract Manager** - The practice list size is now correct when viewing within the **Payment Details** section of **Contract Manager**.
-  **Mail Merge** - There was a discrepancy between the **All Patient** and **Individual QOF** mail merge lists if a patient had a status of **Seen** represented by three dots (...). The **All Patient** list displayed **1st invite** instead of the three dots. SIS 10510 resolves this.
-  **Practice Lists** – The issue of some calculators displaying in lists, has been addressed.

Download Web Files

-  **Pathway ID** – Pathway IDs display when downloading a template from **Download Web Files**. See [Download Web Files](#).


Vision+ Template Designer

Some additional changes are implemented in Vision+ Template Designer:


Hiding the description on a Codeset Row

When adding a **Codeset** row to a template, you can hide the SNOMED CT term/Read code and description, so it does not display when adding.

Below is an example of a template with the SNOMED CT/Read term displayed and with the term hidden:

The SNOMED CT/Read term is visible on the Codeset Add row





The SNOMED CT/Read term does not display on the Codeset Add row

This section summarises adding a Codeset row and changing the row, so the description does not display in the template:

1. From **Template Designer**, select **Home** and **Add Codeset Row** .
2. Your new **Codeset** row displays on the template:



3. Type a description. This can be up to a maximum of 50 characters.
4. Select **Codeset**  at the end of the row to assign your terms.
5. The **Code Search** screen displays:




6. To search on part keywords, select **Partial Match**.
7. Type the term in the search box and select **Search**.
8. From the list of terms, select the term required and choose the **Insert arrow** . The SNOMED CT term displays on the right-hand side of the screen.
9. To close the **Code Search** screen, select **OK**.
10. Now, select the option to **Hide the Description** .

11. The **Hide the Description** screen displays:

or not*




12. To hide the description, select **Yes** then select **OK**.

SNOMED CT Browser Search

The SNOMED CT Code browser search is enhanced in Template Designer. The search now defaults to Terms when searching for a SNOMED CT term.

The issue of you having to re-enter the term if you change the search has been addressed.
