Vision+ SNOMED CT

- 
SNOMED CT – The latest SNOMED CT 29.3 dictionary is implemented in SIS 10540 and includes additional Coronavirus concepts. For more information on Vision's latest Coronavirus guidance see - [Vision Coronavirus Advice](#).

Quality Assurance and Improvement Framework (QAIF) – Vision+ Reports, Templates and Alerts are now fully compliant with the new **Quality Assurance and Improvement Framework (QAIF)** Business rules. For an example of the new look QAIF Reports – see Vision+ Practice Reports page [2](#).

Disable QAIF – From **Vision+ Settings** you can disable QOF prompts and templates. This option is renamed **Disable QAIF** from SIS 10540. See Vision+ Settings – Disable QAIF Triggers page [3](#).

Vision + Template Designer – From **Vision+ Template Designer** you can copy QOF templates and customise them. The templates are renamed QAIF.

Smoking (SMOK002) – **Vision+ Reports** and **Alerts** now exclude any patients with Asthma under the age of 20.

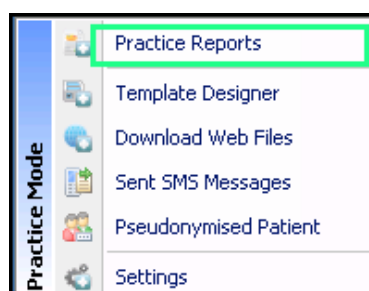
Vision+ QAIF – Wales only

Vision+ is now fully compliant with the new **Quality Assurance and Improvement Framework (QAIF)** Business rules. This includes:

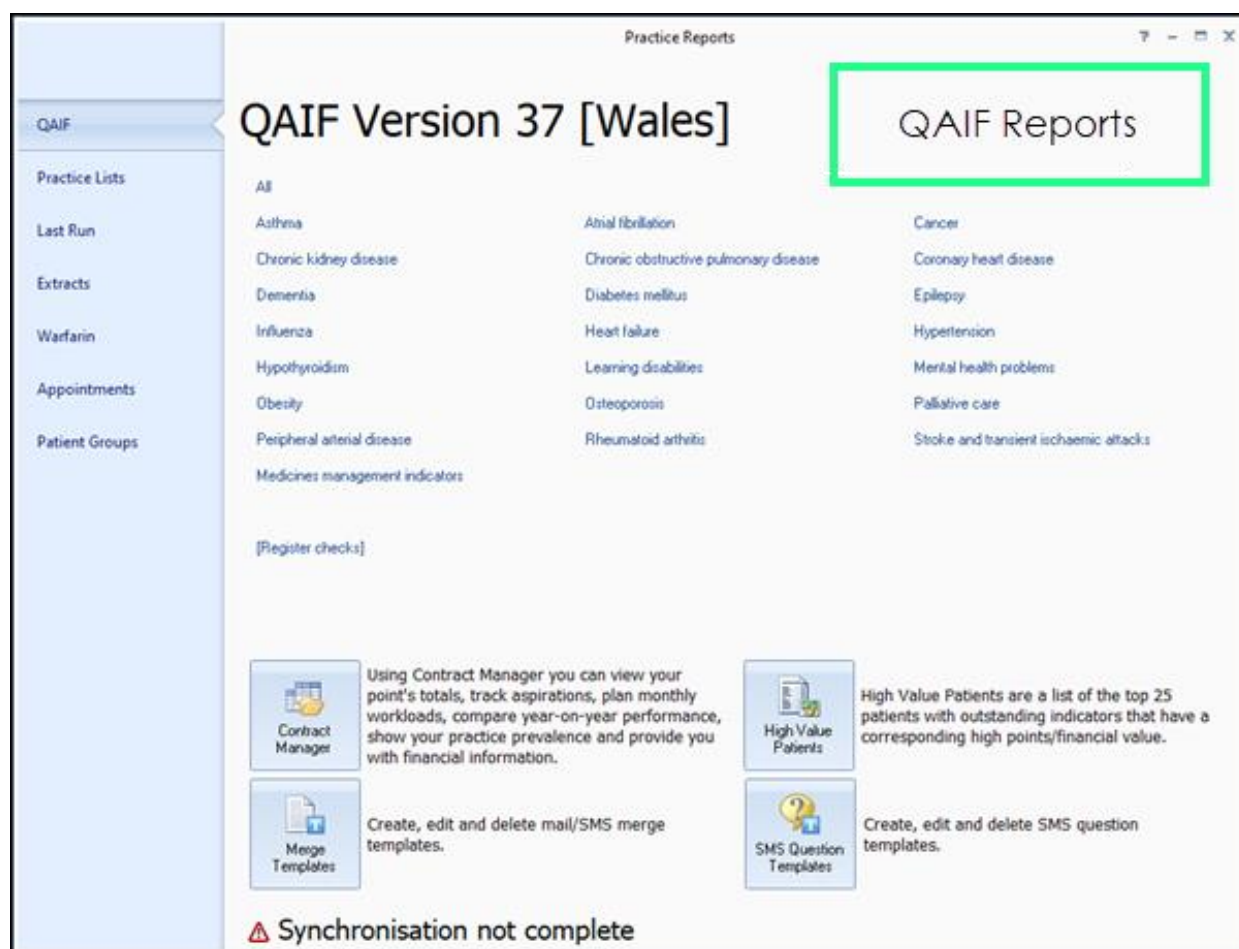
Vision+ Practice Reports

QAIF replaces QOF reports in **Vision+ Reports**. To view and run the reports:

1. Login to **Vision** as usual.
2. From the **Windows Notification** area, right click **Vision+** .
3. Select **Practice Reports**.



4. Vision+ **Practice Reports** screen displays:




Vision+ Settings – Disable QAIF Triggers

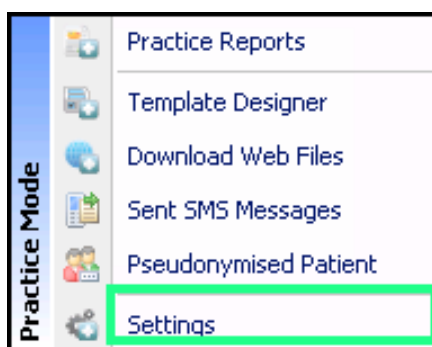
To help manage patient care and optimise QAIF, **Vision+ Alerts** and **Templates** automatically display QAIF prompts.

From **Vision+ Settings** you can hide the prompts, if not required.



Note – This is a user specific setting.

1. Login to **Vision** as usual.
2. From the **Windows Notification** area, right click **Vision+** .
3. Select **Settings**.



4. From **Settings**, select **Advanced**:
