

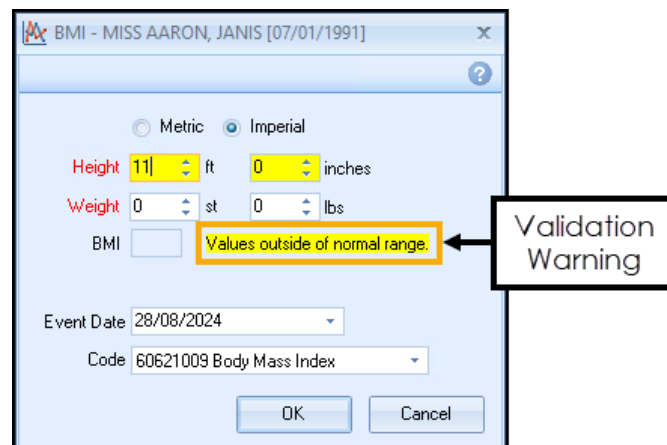

Vision+ Calculators

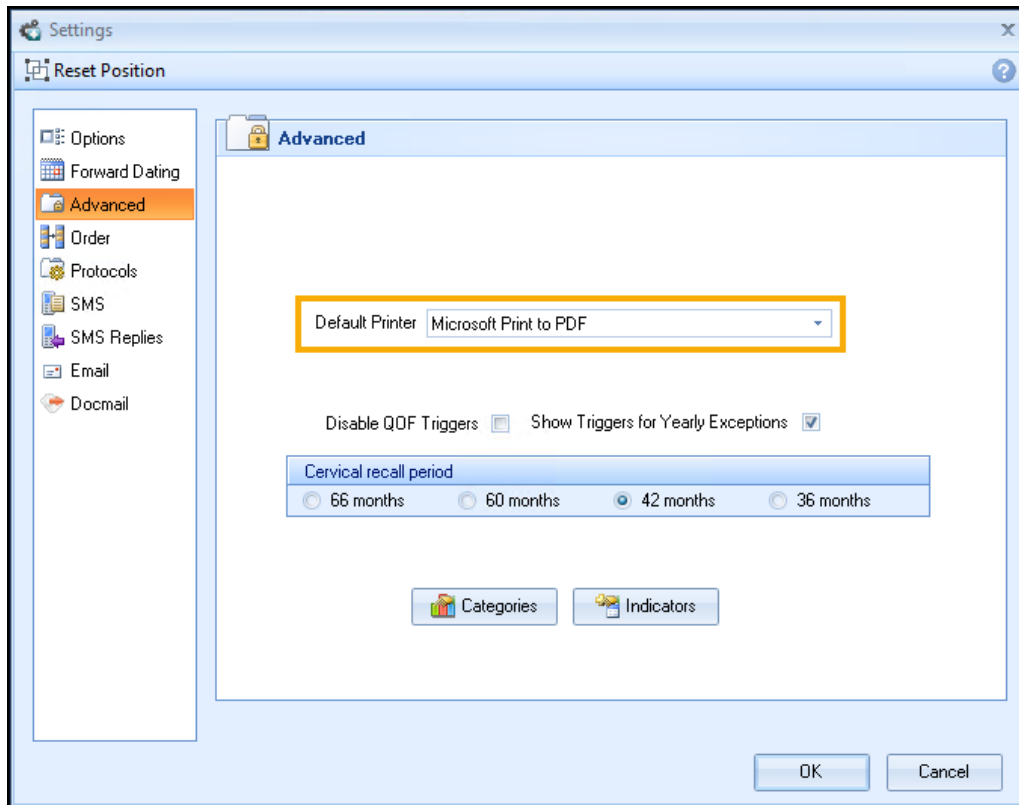
- **BMI Calculator** - If you enter an erroneous value into the **BMI Calculator** a warning displays:

Vision+ SNOMED CT - England Only

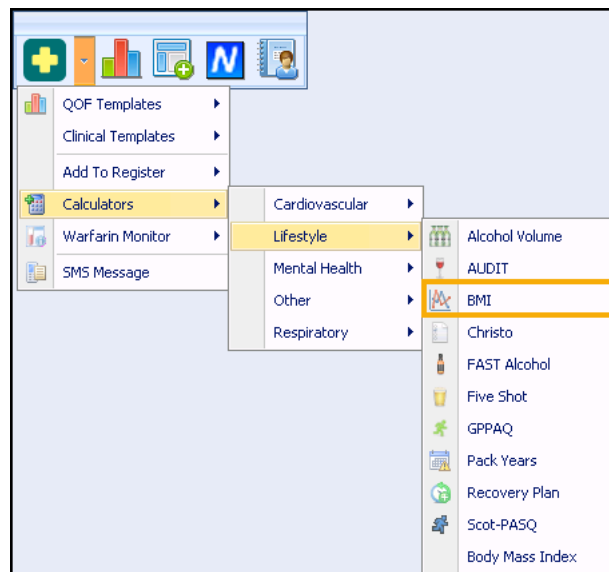
We have removed the dependency on importing **SNOMED CT** dictionary updates into each release and instead are using the shared **SNOMED CT** dictionary delivered via Gemscript. This means the updates happen automatically when your clinical system's dictionary updates.

BMI Calculator


The **BMI Calculator** enables you to quickly input a patient's height and weight values. **Vision+** calculates the patient's BMI and records the appropriate term and result in their record.

Accessing the BMI Calculator

1. From **Consultation Manager**, select the **Vision+** alert screen, highlight the indicator and select **BMI**  or select **Vision+** from the floating toolbar and select **Calculators - Lifestyle - BMI**:




2. The **BMI Calculator** displays:




Select either **Metric** or **Imperial**.

- Enter the **Height** if not already recorded, and enter the patient's **Weight**. These can be entered as a value or select from the drop-down list. If you enter an erroneous value a validation warning displays:



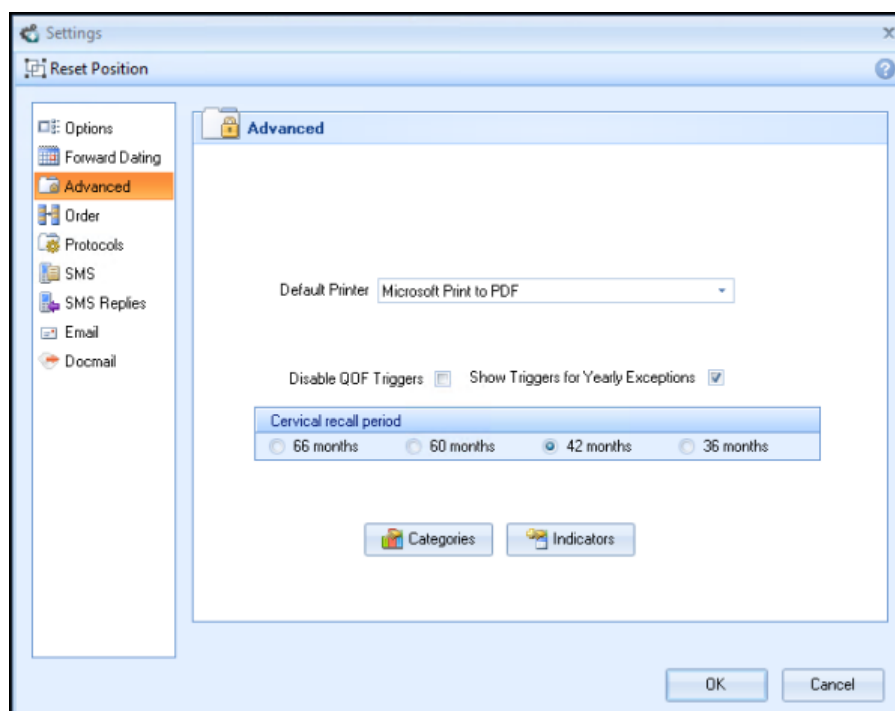
- The **Event Date** defaults to today, edit or use the drop-down list to select an alternative date from the calendar. A default **Code** displays, this can be changed using the drop-down list, for example, with a patient with a BMI over 30 select **Body mass index 30+ - obesity**.

- Select **OK**  to save the changes to the patient record.

The **Code** and the **BMI** value records in the patient's record.

Settings - Advanced

The **Advanced** tab is used to control advanced setting options. It includes the following:



- **Default Printer** - Select the default printer from the printers available on your computer.
- **Disable QOF Triggers** - This option disables the QOF/QAIF triggers from showing, either on the toolbar or the Contract Indicators screen.
- **Show Triggers for Yearly Exceptions** - Select **Show Triggers for Yearly Exceptions** to view any previously recorded exceptions for the current QOF/QAIF year. This is useful if you have previously used an exception code, but may want to record QOF/QAIF data later.
- **Cervical recall period** - This option determines how often cervical smears are required. The default setting is every 5 years, but a small number of health boards require this to be done every three years. Please contact your Health Board if you are unsure.
- **Categories** - Selecting **Categories** provides options to select which whole categories you want to display in the contract indicators screen by placing a check in the corresponding boxes.
- **Indicators** - Selecting **Indicators** provides options to specify which individual indicators within categories display in the contract indicators screen, in much the same way as the Categories.
