

Firearms Marker

The **Firearms Marker** pathway primarily generates patient alerts that display outstanding indicators. This allows you to carry out and record a medical record review for patients at your practice that:

- Have applied for a firearms or shotgun certificate and have a condition of potential concern, or
- Hold a firearms or shotgun certificate, with a new record of a condition of potential concern since the certificate was issued.

Using the Firearms Marker pathway, you can also:

- Open the Clinical Template to easily add appropriate SNOMED CT codes to a patient's record, see Accessing the Firearms Marker Clinical Template on page 3 for details.
- Run a Practice Report to view patients in your practice that have applied for a firearms certificate, hold a firearms certificate, or for whom a review is required, see Running the Firearms Marker Practice Report on page 5 for details.





Accessing the Firearms Marker Template from the Alert Screen


To launch the Firearms Marker Clinical Template from the Alert screen:

- 1. From **Consultation Manager** select the patient required.
- 2. Select Show Other Indicators on the Vision+ floating toolbar



Note - By default QOF/QAIF alerts display when you select a patient in **Consultation Manager**. To combine both QOF/QAIF and non-QOF alerts, see <u>Options - Indicators (opens in the</u> <u>Vision+ Help Centre</u>).

3. The Alert screen displays the Firearms Marker sub category headings expanded to show relevant data:



- 4. To launch the Firearms Marker Clinical Template either:
 - Right click on the Firearms Marker category and select Show Template show Template,
 - Highlight the Firearms Marker category and select Template , or,
 - Double click one of the expanded lines below the Firearms Marker category heading.



Accessing the Firearms Marker Clinical Template

To access the Firearms Marker Clinical Template:

- 1. From **Consultation Manager**, select the patient required.
- 2. Select **Clinical Templates** from the **Vision+** drop-down on the floating toolbar and then select **Firearms Marker**:

The template is split into three tabs:

• History - Displays clinical information from the patient's record.

• Firearms Status - The main template tab, complete as required.

- Information Provides additional information about the Digital Firearms Marker.
- 4. Select **Save & Close** to save the data to the patient's record.

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Note - Once a medical record is marked as reviewed and the alert is disabled, a further application on the same day does not trigger a new alert.



Running the Firearms Marker Practice Report

Vision+ contains a suite of pre-defined **Firearms Marker** reports. From these you can manage your patients list, export to a CSV (spreadsheet) file or use the **Vision+ Mail Merge** facility to contact your patients.

To run and view the Firearms Marker reports:

- 1. Log into Vision 3.
- 2. From the Windows Notification Area, right click Vision+ 1 and select Practice Reports:





Select from:

• **Run Now** - To run the report. The report screen displays with a progress bar.

Training Tip - To run a report for call and recall invite purposes you must select **Run Now**.

• **Schedule** - To schedule the report. The **Schedule** screen displays, enter a start time within the next 24 hours to run the report:

Training Tip - This must be set using the 24 hour clock, for example, for 4pm use 16:00.

You can now continue working as usual and the report runs as per your schedule. Once a report is run it displays in the **Practice Reports** - **Last Run** screen.

• **Cancel** - To exit the confirmation screen.

- CSV File Select to export to a CSV file.
- **Open Patient** Select to open the highlighted patient in **Consultation Manager**.
- **Codeset** Select to add an appropriate clinical term directly into the patient's record.
- Show Template Select to launch the Firearms Marker template for the patient without having to open Consultation Manager. See Accessing the Firearms Marker Clinical Template on page 3 for more details.
- Show Indicators Select to launch the patient's alert pop-up window without having to open **Consultation Manager**.
- Indicator Logic Select to see why the patient is on the cohort list, this opens the pathway in **Pathway Developer**.
